



Need access to free WiFi during the Pathways Conference? Consider the following - but keep in mind that circumstances can change... And wherever you go, be mindful of security when using free public WiFi!

San Antonio Public Library

Free WiFi is available *outside** at 28 SAPL locations from 7:30 a.m.- 10:30 p.m. daily. Some locations have marked the outdoor parking spaces with the strongest signal. Call the library closest to you for more info. (*Some locations do provide computer access inside at certain times but patrons are restricted to one hour on a library computer. SAPL libraries are currently still not open for general use.)

BiblioTech San Antonio

BiblioTech is Bexar County's all digital library and is available to all (and only!) Bexar County residents. Once you have their library card (free; register in person or online at https://bexarbibliotech.org/), you can go check out a hotspot device and/or tablet at one of their three locations. You can also check with a given location about their parking lot WiFi capability. Like SAPL, inside computer use is restricted to one hour when they are open.

Local Malls

North Star Mall (Look for the WiFi network called .NorthStarMallGuest and enter in your email address for free WiFi access), Rivercenter Mall, and Ingram Park Mall may provide free WiFi access locations. It would be a good idea to check this out ahead of the conference to determine where you will be able to connect.

San Antonio Airport

Free WiFi is available throughout the terminals, and the "cell phone" lot, but it may be monitored.

San Antonio Parks

Although City community centers are still closed, WiFi access should still be available in their parking lots near the building. Also, a number of area parks provide free WiFi access. Go to https://www.sanantonio.gov/ParksAndRec/Parks-Facilities/Wi-Fi-Services to check out locations. Access should be near a park building or in the park's parking lot. Again, it would be a good idea to check this out in person at the center or park ahead of time.

San Antonio Cooling Centers

These locations are in community or senior centers or libraries and will have WiFi access; you just need to bring your own device. Go to

https://www.saoemprepare.com/BeInformed/NaturalDisasters/Heat/CoolingCenters for locations and times. Most of these places are only open Monday -Friday.

Local Restaurants

A number of cafés, coffee shops and restaurants provide free WiFi access to customers. Contact your favorite ahead of time to make sure they have access - and don't mind you camping out for a while!

College Campuses

If you are a registered student, check with your institution regarding WiFi access locations on campus.
